ANTH 221: Intro to Cultural Anthropology (3)

Considers how cultural learning shapes human behavior from a cross-cultural anthropological perspective. Aspects of culture examined include language, adaptation, economics, marriage, kinship, gender, political organization, stratification, and religion.
